### IS IT BULLYING?

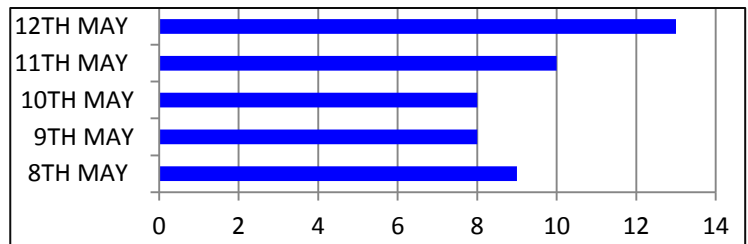
We have done a lot of work this week with our pupils on bullying. Please see poster for what we have been discussing.
