Physical Education:

Your child will be having P.E. on the following days:

4I - Monday	4C - Monday	4E - Thursday
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The school PE kit is a dark top with no logo, dark bottoms/shorts and suitable footwear such as trainers or pumps. If your child does not have the appropriate P.E. kit/uniform then you will be telephoned and you will be required to bring this into school. We will be teaching PE outside so please make sure your child is wearing a P.E kit that is appropriate for the weather.

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Swimming:

The pupils in year 4 will be swimming **Wednesday** at Mile End Leisure Centre. Your child will need to bring the following items:

- Swimming costume/trunks (more information on next page)
- Towel
- Swimming hat
- Carrier bag for wet clothes
- Water bottle
- Goggles (optional, but recommended)
- A healthy snack (optional)

Homework:

Every week, all pupils across the school will get the following:

1) Weekly spelling words to learn. Please help your child learn to spell their words in whatever way you like.

2) Multiplication tables practice/ basic number bonds. Pupils will be given set multiplications/number bonds to learn at home. KS2 will also continue to have access to the online 'Times Table Rockstar' programme.

3) Question to discuss. Every week, we will be giving the pupils a question to discuss with their families. This will be based on what they have been learning in class, or will look forward to future learning. There is no expectation that pupils write anything or bring anything back to school, but they are more than welcome to make notes or present their work if they wish!

4) Reading. We still expect pupils to read at home every night for at least 20 minutes but we will no longer be asking for this to be recorded in reading logs. Pupils can bring books home from their class library. Please continue to read with your child, or listen to them read and to ask questions about what they have read.

In addition to this, all pupils can access their **Reading Plus** account from home.
