Physical Education:

Your child will be having P.E. on the following days:

4I - PE - Monday Swimming - Friday	4C - PE - Wednesday Swimming - Friday	4E - PE - Tuesday Swimming - Friday
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The school PE kit is a dark top with no logo, dark bottoms/shorts and suitable footwear such as trainers or pumps.



Should your child not have the appropriate P.E. and swimming kit/uniform then you will be telephoned and you will be required to bring this into school.

We may be teaching PE outside so as the weather gets colder, please make sure your child is wearing a P.E kit that is appropriate.

Swimming will be every **Friday from 19th September 2025 to end of the Autumn Term.**

NB: swimming caps can be purchased from the office at the cost of £3.

Homework:

Every week, all pupils across the school will get the following:

1) Weekly spelling words to learn. Please help your child learn to spell their words .

2) Multiplication tables practice/ basic number bonds. Pupils will be given set multiplications/number bonds to learn at home. KS2 will also continue to have access to the online '**Times Table Rockstar**' programme.

3) Reading. We still expect pupils to read at home every night for at least 20 minutes but we will no longer be asking for this to be recorded in reading logs. Pupils can bring books home from their class library. Please continue to read with your child, or listen to them read and to ask questions about what they have read.

In addition to this, all pupils can access their **Reading Plus** account from home.

Your child will receive their homework every **Friday**. This will need to be brought back to school on **Tuesday**. Pupils should also be taking reading books home regularly to read independently.

In addition to this, all pupils have an account with Reading Plus and Timestables Rockstars which they can access from home.
