English

Pupils will be continuing with the Read Write Inc phonic programme where they will be learning strategies for reading which include sounding out words and blending. They will also develop their comprehension skills and develop their writing skills.

Shared reading and extended writing

Pupils will be reading a variety of books this half term such as 'Room on the Broom' and 'Owl Babies'. Pupils will develop their comprehension skills and vocabulary. Pupils will also be completing a weekly piece of writing based on the book they are reading.

Mathematics

In mathematics we will be completing a number of topics including numbers within 20 and adding and subtracting within 20. We will also be continuing working on our fluency skills such as counting forwards and backwards.

Science

In science this half term we will study Materials and Forces. We will be looking at properties of everyday materials, classifying materials and simple forces such as pushes and pulls.

RE

In RE this half term pupils will be completing the topic Judaism where pupils will be learning about who Jewish people are and what they believe in. We will also be visiting Sandy's Row Synagogue, please see important dates below.

<u>Design and Technology</u>

Pupils will be completing a D&T unit food, where pupils will create their own healthy breakfast pot.
