Physical Education

Your child will be having P.E. on the following days:

- **3E – Wednesdays and Fridays**
- **3C – Mondays and Tuesdays**
- **3I – Mondays and Thursdays**

If your child does not have the appropriate P.E. kit/uniform, then you will be telephoned and you will be required to bring this into school.

Homework

We have reviewed the way we set homework to make it consistent across the school and appropriate for pupils to complete independently. Every week, all pupils across the school will get the following:

1) Weekly spelling words to learn. Please help your child learn to spell their words in whatever way you like. There are some suggested activities further on in this newsletter.

2) Multiplication tables practice/ basic number bonds. Pupils will be given set multiplications/number bonds to learn at home. KS2 will also continue to have access to the online 'Times Table Rockstar' programme.

3) Question to discuss. Every week, we will be giving the pupils a question to discuss with their families. This will be based on what they have been learning in class, or will look forward to future learning. There is no expectation that pupils write anything or bring anything back to school, but they are more than welcome to make notes or

present their work if they wish!

Reading

We still expect pupils to read at home every night for at least 20 minutes but we will no longer be asking for this to be recorded in reading logs.

Pupils will be bringing books home from their class library corners or will be given specific books to read. Please continue to read with your child, or listen to them read and to ask questions about what they have read. We will be discussing books they have been reading in class and they will have the opportunity to talk about their books to their class.
