2) Multiplication tables practice/ basic number bonds. Pupils will be given set multiplications/number bonds to learn at home. KS2 will also continue to have access to the online '**Times Table Rockstar**' programme or log on to timestables.co.uk

3) Reading. We still expect pupils to read at home every night for at least 20 minutes but we will no longer be asking for this to be recorded in reading logs.



Pupils can bring books home from their class library. Please continue to read with your child, or listen to them read and to ask questions about what they have read.

In addition to this, all pupils can access their Reading Plus account from home. Should they not be able to do reading plus - they should be reading books. It is really important to listen to your child read out aloud.
