

Academy Council meeting 09/06/26

Today's meeting was a more informal one. We had more parents than usual at the meeting so we will continue next year with the coffee/tea and biscuits format.

Kevin read through the notes from the last meeting. Parents were still concerned about the condition of the school toilets, some reporting that their child 'holds on' until they get home.

Kevin said that after the last meeting he has spoken to the premises staff about regular checks and that the pupil school council have this item regularly on their agenda. We are doing our best to encourage the children to use the toilets correctly and not make a mess of them and we will continue working on this.

Swimming lessons were discussed. Kevin said that the mobile pool will be back in September for the whole of the Autumn term. Parents were pleased about this but had heard a few parents worried about walking the short distance from the pool to the changing area. It was suggested that these children could bring robes to wear.

Parent classes were brought up again. Kevin had sent out a survey but there was no response to this. If parents wanted to have e.g. keep fit classes, we would be happy to host and the cost would be split between the parents attending.

Other items discussed:

- Healthy eating - all KS1 pupils have fresh fruit at break. Tesco's on Roman Road will be donating fruit to the school for all pupils on a regular basis. Pupils are also able to bring in their own fruit if they wish
- Clubs - will be enrolled again in the new school year
